They will share facts and figures about folks in Virginia that are waiting on a transplant, how to sign up to be an organ donor, and what roles the community can play to help to share this mission. **Invitation to the New Testament**-The pastor's next Bible Study will be "*Invitation to the New Testament*," which will be held on Thursdays, 1-3 p.m., beginning April 22.
